



## **Appointment of New Chairman of FPSC**

In pursuance of Establishment Division Notification No. 41/02/2019-E-I, dated 05.09.2024 and FPSC Notification dated 07.10.2024, Lt. Gen. Akhtar Nawaz Satti (Retd.), HI (M), assumed the charge of office of the Chairman FPSC on 09.10.2024. President Mr. Asif Ali Zardari administered the oath of office to Lt. Gen. Akhtar Nawaz Satti (Retd.), HI (M) in a ceremony held at the Presidency on 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2024. The oath taking ceremony was attended by Members of FPSC Federal Secretaries and senior officers of the President's Secretariat. The President congratulated Lt. Gen. Akhtar Nawaz Satti (Retd.), on joining the office of Chairman FPSC and wished him success for performing his duties honestly for selection of civil services on merit.

## **Oath Taking of New Members for the Commission**

Oath taking ceremony for newly appointed Members FPSC, Mr. Mohammad Mushtaq Ahmed and Mr. Muhammad Syrus Sajjad Qazi, was administered by the Chairman FPSC on 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2024, under Section 4-A of the Federal Public Service Commission Ordinance, 1977.

## **Presentation of FPSC Annual Report-2023 to the President of Pakistan**

The Chairman FPSC, Lt. Gen. Akhtar Nawaz Satti (Retd.) called on the President, Mr. Asif Ali Zardari at Aiwan-e-Sadar Islamabad on 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2024 to present the FPSC Annual Report-2023 as required under section 9 of the FPSC Ordinance, 1977, which covered functions and activities of the Commission during calendar year 2023. The President emphasized that FPSC had an important role to play in the restructuring and strengthening of civil services of the country. He appreciated the efforts of FPSC and hoped that the Commission would continue to strive towards introducing positive change.

## **Farewell to Outgoing Member of FPSC**

A farewell ceremony was arranged in the honour of outgoing Member FPSC, Ms. Yasmeen Masood in a meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> November, 2024 at conference room of FPSC Headquarters, Islamabad. The Commission expressed profound sense of admiration for her efforts and commendable services for selection of quality human resource for the public service. Her illustrious contributions to the organization were widely appreciated.

## Activities Relating to CSS Competitive Examination during October-December 2024

### Special CSS Competitive Examination 2023

- Personal hearings were granted by the Commission to 26 rejected candidates of special CSS 2023.
- Result of written part of Special CSS Competitive Examination was announced on 04.12.2024. Salient features of the result are as under:

Candidates Applied	21947
Candidates Appeared	15245
Candidates passed in written Exam	519
Pass percentage w.r.t appeared candidates	3.40%

- Psychological Assessment of 136 candidates was conducted during the quarter October-December, 2024.

### Competitive Examination 2024

- Post examination detailed scrutiny of 15602 present candidates of CE-2024 remained under progress during the quarter under report.

### Competitive Examination 2025

- Preliminary Test for CSS-2025 (MPT) was held on 17.11.2024 in two batches, Result was announced vide FPSC press note dated 20.12.2024. 44445 candidates appeared, out of which 31265 candidates qualified the preliminary test.
- FPSC advertisement dated 22.12.2024 invited online applications for written part of CSS CE-2025 from MPT qualifiers.

## Activities relating to General Recruitment (October-December) 2024

- During the quarter October-December 2024, FPSC advertised 177 vacancies relating to BS-16 and above belonging to different Ministries, Divisions and Departments. Against such vacancies, 21,166 applications were received online.
- Under general recruitment stream, Professional Screening Tests/Written Descriptive Test Phase-III&IV/2024 was held involving 93 cases comprising 1184 posts. For this test phase, 148,751 applications were received and 62,942 candidates appeared in the tests.
- 15 requisitions from Ministries/Divisions/Departments for advice on Recruitment Rules were received and processed.
- During the quarter October-December, the Commission conducted interviews and personal hearings of 3106 candidates.

## **Other activities performed by the FPSC during (October-December) 2024**

- The Commission prepared test schemes and syllabi of 56 cases of general recruitment involving 177 posts of BS-16 and above as referred to the Commission.
  - Schedule for FPO examination-2025 (51<sup>st</sup> CTP) fresh/failed probationers of earlier batches was issued.
  - Examination was conducted for induction of PMS/PCS Officers into PAS (BS-19). Against 26 posts, 40 candidates were registered. Out of them, 21 appeared in the examination whereas 14 candidates were shortlisted for further process.
  - 69 appeals/petitions relating to General Recruitment cases were decided at various forums.
  - 401869 SMS and 796 e-mails were sent to the candidates on their given cell phone numbers and e-mails addresses acknowledging their online applications and intimating about major events including, schedule of tests, interviews, personal hearing etc.
  - Over 13458 e-mails, concerning queries & clarifications of the applicants, were received and appropriately responded during October-December 2024.
