- 2009-12: Consul General of Pakistan, Toronto, Canada.
- 2012-15: Ambassador & Deputy Permanent Representative to the United Nations, New York.
- 2018-19: Ambassador/High Commissioner for Pakistan to the United Kingdom.
- 2019-21: Ambassador to the Republic Cuba, with concurrent accreditation to Republic of Haiti, Republic of Nicaragua, Grenada, and Honduras.
- 2021-23: Ambassador to the Kingdom of Thailand.

He assumed charge as Member (FPSC) on 07 November 2025.

Ambassador Khan holds a Master's degree in 'International Public Policy and Politics' from SAIS, Johns Hopkins University, United States.
