FPSC Achieves Improvement in Recruitment Output and Case Disposal in 2025

Islamabad: The Federal Public Service Commission (FPSC) has recorded **remarkable improvement in recruitment performance during 2025**, finalizing **3,005 nominations**, the highest annual output in recent years. It has been possible due to positive impact of internal reforms. The FPSC has also assigned **priority to recruitment for education and health sectors**, as well as cases from **Baluchistan and Gilgit-Baltistan**. Additionally, **due to remodeling of internal business processes, the average timeline for completion of cases, previously 18–24 months, has been reduced to 5–7 months.**

During 2025, FPSC successfully completed allocation for **CSS 2023 (Special) and CSS 2024**. Moreover, **65% of CSS 2025 interviews have been completed.**

To pursue long-awaited reforms, a detailed briefing was made to the **Prime Minister by the FPSC**. The **Prime Minister** has constituted a **committee under the Chair of the Federal Minister for Planning**. The reforms suggested by FPSC, shall **significantly enhance FPSC's efficiency and performance in the coming years.**
