167th Meeting of the Commission

The 167th Meeting of the Commission was held on 15th August, 2023 at the FPSC HQs. Mr. Shahid Ashraf Tarar, Chairman FPSC presided over the meeting. Members of the Commission and Senior Management of the Secretariat were also invited to discuss various agenda items of strategic importance being tabled before the Commission and conveyed to facilitate the Secretariat in making decisions on issues to further policy formulation based on collective wisdom. The Chairman highlighted the milestones achieved. Key decisions relating to improvement in working of the Commission and the way forward were taken.

Meeting for Re-Evaluation of CSS Rules, 2019

Existing CSS-CE rules were framed in 2019. Since then, many developments have taken place highlighting the requirement of revising such rules in order to harmonize them with contemporary environment. In this regard, a preliminary meeting was held on 18.07.2023 in conference room of the FPSC Headquarter, Islamabad. The meeting was chaired by Secretary, FPSC. Senior officers also participated in the meeting and gave their input. Draft revised rules are under process which will be submitted for consideration of the Commission.

Meeting for Equivalence and Relevance of Qualification/Degrees

A meeting of the Equivalence Committee was held on 21st September, 2023 in the Conference room, Federal Public Service Commission, Headquarters Islamabad. The meeting was presided by Mr. Fazal Abbas Maken, Senior Member of the Commission. Agenda of the meeting was to deliberate on Matters relating to equivalence and relevance of qualifications/Degrees and recommendations of the Commission's Committee relating to recruitment to different posts. Important decisions were taken for future compliance and implementation under purview of FPSC.

Activities regarding CSS during (July-September) 2023

1. COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION-2022

a. Induction of Armed Forces Officers into Civil Services: Ministry of Defence nominated 30 officers i.e. 19 from Army, 06 from Air Force and 5 from Navy for induction into Civil Service on the basis of CE-2022. Their Psychological Assessment and Viva Voce were held as per following schedules:

- a. **Personal Hearings of Pre exam Rejected candidates of CE-2023:** During the period July to September, 2023, personal hearings of 177 pre-exam rejected candidates of CE-2023 were held at Islamabad, Karachi, Lahore & Peshawar centres respectively.
- b. **Detail of Rejected Candidates of CE-2023 Post exam Scrutiny:** 13008 candidates appeared in written part of CE-2023. After detailed scrutiny of their particulars, candidature of 261 candidates was rejected.

General Recruitment Activities during July-September, 2023

i. Advertisement

The Commission released **03** consolidated advertisements through print media as well as FPSC website www.fpsc.gov.pk for inviting online applications for recruitment to **2309** vacancies in BS-16 and above, which were requisitioned by different Ministries/ Divisions/ Departments, during the **3**rd **Quarter of 2023**.

ii. Interview and Final Selection

The Commission finalized 46 cases of general recruitment. In these cases interviews of 787 short listed eligible candidates were conducted against 299 vacancies and

recommendations of 208 qualified candidates for various posts in BS-16 to BS-19 were processed. FPSC reported 90 vacancies unfilled to the requisitioning Ministries/ Divisions/ Departments due to non-availability of eligible and qualified candidates from specific province/ region/ quota and failure of candidates in interviews. 1 vacancy was withdrawn due to administrative issues of the department. Under Section 7(3) (d) of the FPSC Ordinance 1977, aggrieved candidates are provided with an opportunity to file Representations/Review Petitions for redressal of their grievances, after which they can approach High Courts for adjudication if desired. Details of litigation, by or against the Commission in various Courts of Law indicate that out of 606 Cases, 53 were decided during quarter July-September, 2023.
